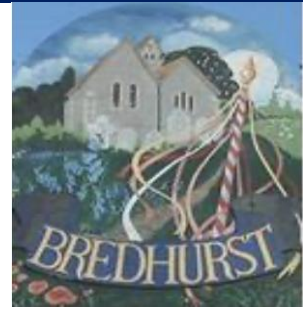


BREDHURST PARISH COUNCIL

Bredhurst Parish Council is made up of 7 Councillors. Due to a recent resignation, we are looking for another councillor to fill this vacancy.

The Parish Council has responsibility for the following amenities:

- Allotments
- Playing Field and Playground
- Blacksmith Barn
- Bredhurst Village Hall

What Is Involved:

We need people of all ages, backgrounds and experiences who have an interest and want to make a real difference in their community.

You will be expected to attend monthly meetings, normally held on the 2nd Wednesday of the month except August and January.

Full training will be given.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Over 18 years of age.
- A British citizen, or an eligible Commonwealth citizen.

Plus, One or More of the Following:

- Registered as a local government elector for Bredhurst Parish from the day of your nomination.
- Live in or within 3 miles of the Bredhurst parish boundary for the whole of the 12 months prior to your nomination and the day of election.
- Work in the Parish for the whole of the 12 months prior to your nomination and the day of election.
- Own land or other premises within the Parish boundary.
- Not be a bankrupt or have received a jail sentence within the past 5 years (suspended or not).
